Privacy Policy

A. Who We Are

The Association for the Treatment of Tobacco Use and Dependence (ATTUD) is a volunteer organization dedicated to the promotion of and increased access to evidence-based tobacco treatment information and services, as well as advancing the field of tobacco dependence treatment.

B. Information We Collect

We collect basic personal information that you voluntarily provide, including but not limited to:

- Name
- Contact information (for example, email address, telephone number, mailing address)
- Educational background
- TTS Certification status
- Employer, position, location, work activities
- Professional society / organization memberships
- Payment status and history (for example, membership dues, internal continuing education and other program offerings)
- Volunteer interests
- Donation information (if applicable)

C. How We Use Information

- Maintain organization records
- Communicate with members and volunteers
- Organize events and activities
- Send updates about programs and events
- ATTUD direct marketing to our membership
- Report aggregate data (that does not identify you) on membership characteristics
- Process donations

D. Information Sharing

- With service providers or other organizations ATTUD employs or collaborates with to assist with general or specific ATTUD activities
- When required by law
- To report aggregate data (that does not identify you) for research and other reports (when such opportunities are present)
- *Note: We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information*

E. Data Security

We take reasonable measures to protect the personal information we collect from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure.

F. Your Choices

- Request access to the personal information we maintain about you
- Request corrections to your information
- Ask to be removed from our email or contact lists
- Request to cancel membership
